We ask the Chinese Embassy in Poland to forward this letter to the authorities of the Chinese Communist Party.

On behalf of the **New Covenant Church in Lublin**, a religious association registered in the Register of Churches and Religious Associations under number 132, we present the following position on the damage and harm: caused by the Communist Party of China to Polish citizens who are members of our Church, and suffered by the Church, which is a legal person, in relation to the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus in Poland.

Our position, presented below, is based on the belief that the Communist Party of China is fully responsible for the spread of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus worldwide.

Media reports, supported by evidence, indicate that in the autumn of 2019, cases of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus infection were reported in China. Because of the totalitarian and anti-civil activities of the Communist Party of China, these facts were hidden from the world. The people of China who wanted to inform and warn international community about their lives and health, were persecuted by the Communist Party of China. In January 2020, the virus spread to all of China and began to spread to the world. At that time, the Communist Party of China maintained a passive attitude and concealed knowledge of the deadly virus spreading rapidly.

1 This indicates that it was the Chinese Communist Party that caused harm and  
2 damage to all those who are infected and are at risk of being infected by the SARS-CoV-2  
3 coronavirus.

4 In connection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus epidemic, **the New Covenant**  
5 **Church in Lublin** suffered the following harm and damage:

6 We cannot organize public Christian services and meetings.

7 We were forced to cancel a cyclical event for several hundred people - the Christian  
8 Congress - which was to take place in Lublin in mid-March. Due to the fact that foreign  
9 guests were invited to the congress, we incurred costs such as airline tickets,  
10 accommodation reservations, etc.

14 The spread of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus resulted in the need to close our online  
15 shop, which in effect prevented the distribution of Holy Scripture and Christian literature.

16 The spread of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus creates an atmosphere of anxiety,  
17 discomfort and fear about our future and the future of our business.

18 Our missionary activities: eye-to-eye conversations with people, distribution of  
19 leaflets and materials, and Holy Scriptures - were made almost completely impossible.

20 We were forced to cancel construction works in the new headquarters of our  
21 Church - which led to large financial outlays to secure current construction works.

22 Church members were exposed to separation and lack of contact with other  
23 believers, which particularly affects the youth of our Church.

24 Some members of the Church, i.e. doctors, policemen, firemen, were forced to work  
25 in difficult conditions.

1 The Chinese Communist Party is responsible for all of this and we therefore  
2 demand that representatives of the Chinese Communist Party publicly acknowledge their  
3 responsibility for failing to prevent the epidemic from spreading, and for concealing  
4 information about the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

5 We are aware that we cannot demand anything more from the Chinese Communist  
6 Party, but we want to join the ever wider front of people in the world who point to  
7 communism and the Chinese Communist Party as the cause of the SARS-CoV-2  
8 coronavirus epidemic, which has already affected the whole world.
